RESOLUTION NO. 2020-170

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK **FOR** PREPARATION. IMPLEMENTATION. AND **ADMINISTRATION** BY BROWARD COUNTY OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK'S COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEARS 2017-2018, 2018-2019, AND 2019-2020; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2007, the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek approved a motion to accept the City as an entitlement grantee of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the responsibilities associated with that status; and

WHEREAS, the City is designated as an entitlement city pursuant to 24 C.F.R Part 570.4, with a population in excess of 50,000, entitling City to receive CDBG funds directly from HUD and implement its own CDBG programs; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) encourages the establishment of joint local housing assistance programs, and authorizes local governments to enter into interlocal agreements to establish and implement such programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and Broward County desire to address the housing needs of their respective residents and to promote the efficient location, design, and provision of affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and Broward County believe that the establishment of a joint local housing assistance program is an efficient use of resources; and

WHEREAS, the City is designated as an entitlement city pursuant to 24 C.F.R Part 570.4, entitling the City to receive its own allocation of CDBG Program funds; however, the City desires for the County to receive the City's allocation of CDBG Program funding and administer the CDBG Program funds pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement between the County and the City for the Preparation, Implementation and Administration by the County for the City's CDBG Program for the Fiscal Years 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines it to be in the best interest of the residents of the City of Coconut Creek to enter into said agreement with Broward County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached agreement between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek for the Preparation, Implementation and Administration by the County for the City's CDBG Program for the Fiscal Years 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020.

<u>Section 3:</u> That the Mayor and the City Manager, or designee, are hereby authorized to execute said agreement between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
