

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-233**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPROVE A CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,300.72 TO P.L.A. ELECTRIC, INC. FOR ADDITIONAL ELECTRICAL SERVICES AT TEMPORARY FIRE STATION 113; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on January 24, 2019, the City Commission awarded a contract to P.L.A. Electric, Inc. to provide for electrical contracted services citywide pursuant to RFP No.12-05-18-10; and

**WHEREAS**, a P-Card Authorization, in the amount of \$44,855.00 to P.L.A. Electric, Inc., was approved on March 30, 2021, to install power to and around the building; and

**WHEREAS**, in the process of performing electrical services for the construction of Temporary Fire Station 113, additional work was deemed necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, P.L.A. Electric was already working on the project from the inception, and familiar with the property, the building, and all the utility lines at that location; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends approval of this change order to P.L.A. Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$45,300.72 for the aforementioned purpose.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1:** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

**Section 2:** That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to approve the Change Order to P.L.A. Electric, Inc., in the amount of \$45,300.72 for the purpose of installing additional electrical services required at Temporary Fire Station 113.

**Section 3:** That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

**Section 4:** That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
