

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-132**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY MASTER ASSOCIATION (TCMA) APPLICATION FOR MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE NEIGHBORHOOD ENHANCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM FOR PHASE II OF THE MULTI-PHASE LANDSCAPE DESIGN PROJECT TO RESTORE THE TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY LANDSCAPE BUFFERS; PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coconut Creek has funded a Neighborhood Enhancement Grant Program to provide matching funds for enhancements to the City's neighborhoods and communities; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 10, 2016, TCMA was approved for \$20,000 in matching funds from the Neighborhood Enhancement Grant Program for a multi-phase landscape design project to establish community-wide landscape design guidelines and a five-year, multi-phase installation plan; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 26, 2017, TCMA was approved for \$20,000 in matching funds from the Neighborhood Enhancement Grant Program to restore the Township community landscape buffers for Phase I of a multi-phase landscape design project, including the Sawgrass Village I, Golden Raintree III, and Bayport Village neighborhoods within the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, TCMA has applied for \$20,000 in matching funds from the Neighborhood Enhancement Grant Program to restore the Township community landscape buffers for Phase II of a multi-phase landscape design project, including the Pond Apple Place I, Pond Apple Place III, Pond Apple Place IV, Karanda Village V, Golden Raintree I, and Golden Raintree IV neighborhoods within the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, TCMA will provide matching funds for labor and installation; and

**WHEREAS,** the Neighborhood Enhancement Grant Program provides for a maximum reimbursement up to \$20,000 per year; and

**WHEREAS,** TCMA is responsible for maintenance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1:** That the City Commission hereby approves the TCMA application for \$20,000 in matching funds from the Neighborhood Enhancement Grant Program for Phase II of the multi-phase landscape design project.

**Section 2:** That TCMA is responsible for providing matching funds for the labor, installation, and maintenance.

**Section 3:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
