## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-028**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING AND ADOPTING THE BROWARD COUNTY JULY 2023 REVISION TO THE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY (LMS); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coconut Creek is located in an area that is vulnerable to natural and man-made disasters; and

**WHEREAS**, the City supports reasonable efforts to make the community better prepared for future disasters and better able to recover after disaster strikes; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida has stipulated that a Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) is the first step in the process of making a community better prepared to manage disasters; and

**WHEREAS,** by adopting the Broward County July 2023 revision to the mulitjurisdictional LMS, the framework for future mitigation efforts and post-disaster recovery may be made easier and faster; and

WHEREAS, the Broward County July 2023 LMS is in compliance with the local hazard mitigation requirements of Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA2K), as implemented in Title 44, Part 201, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR); and

**WHEREAS,** approval and adoption of the Plan is necessary in order to maintain eligibility for hazard mitigation project grant funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds and determines that adopting the above described LMS is in the best interests of the residents, businesses and visitors of the City and serves a public service.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

**Section 1:** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission hereby approves and adopts the Broward County July 2023 revision of the multi-jurisdictional LMS as approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as meeting all current requirements for such a plan.

<u>Section 3:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

**Section 4:** That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
