

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-025

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE SCHOOL SURVEILLANCE CAMERA SYSTEM ACCESS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the School Board of Broward County ("SBBC") and the City of Coconut Creek ("City") previously entered into a School Surveillance Camera System Access Agreement approved by Resolution No. 2022-205 on October 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the agreement to clarify that the City will have access to both real time (live) and recorded video feeds from the SBBC's surveillance cameras when a call is received through the E-911 system, the SBBC's mobile alert system (Alyssa's Alert), or additional SBBC strategies or systems, of an emergency occurring on or near the grounds of a district school or facility; and

WHEREAS, the SBBC and the City agree that allowing police personnel to have access to real time video feeds at the schools will help protect the school administration, students, and the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City to provide every possible means of protection for the benefit of the public schools located within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached first amendment to the School Surveillance Camera System Access Agreement between the School Board of Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the first amendment to the School Surveillance Camera System Access Agreement between the School Board of Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
