On February 3, 2021, at approximately 10:41 p.m., Sergeant Mullin responded to a horrific crash at the intersection of Hillsboro Boulevard and Lyons Road that was observed by Officer Feisthammel. A vehicle that was stopped at the light was rear ended by another vehicle that was traveling at a high rate of speed. Officer Feisthammel quickly approached the vehicle that had a driver trapped inside. Moments later, Sergeant Mullin arrived on scene. Shortly after his arrival, the second vehicle began to smoke. Sergeant Mullin and another witness, went to assist the driver in getting out of the car. As the two were attempting to help the man, he went unconscious in the vehicle while still seat belted in.

Sergeant Mullin and the civilian witness were able to unlatch the seatbelt and start pulling the unconscious man out of the vehicle. Unbeknownst to them, the man's foot was stuck and they were initially unable to move him. As the engine compartment became engulfed in flames, Sergeant Mullin and the civilian witness diligently worked to free the unconscious man's foot and pull his limp body to safety. Both cars sustained substantial damage and both drivers were transported Level 1 Trauma to Broward North by fire rescue.

If not for their expedient, life-saving actions, this victim may not have survived this accident.
