WHEREAS, it is a proven benefit that trees sequester carbon dioxide, which serves to reduce the City’s carbon footprint; and

WHEREAS, trees can reduce the erosion of topsoil by wind and water, cut heating and cooling costs, moderate the temperature, clean the air, produce oxygen, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, trees in our City increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has been recognized as a Tree City USA by the National Arbor Day Foundation since 1989; and

WHEREAS, it is the City’s intention to continue promoting the benefits of trees; and

WHEREAS, it is with great pride that the City shares this tradition with the Coconut Creek Rotary Club through a tree planting ceremony on the grounds of City Hall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, hereby proclaims April 26, 2018, as

“ARBOR DAY 2018”

in the City of Coconut Creek and urges all residents to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands, to support our City’s urban forestry program, and to plant and maintain trees to promote the well-being of present and future generations.
