1. The meeting was called to order by Assistant Director of Sustainable Development Justin Proffitt at 11:34 a.m.

Senior Code Compliance Officer Briana Capone presented a brief timeline for case number C15040479. There was a total of 31 staff hours spent on this case. Senior Code Compliance Officer Briana Capone presented that the fine for case number C15040479 accrued for 260 days at \$50.00 per day with a one-time administrative fee of \$25.00 for a total fine amount of \$13,025.00.

Thomas Cotton, owner of the property was present for case number C15040479. He explained that he was incarcerated, went through a divorce and bankruptcy and was unable to pay the original agreed upon amount. He stated that during his bankruptcy we received a payment of \$1,287.79 and asked for another settlement agreement. The property was brought into compliance by Winston Park Foundation.

The board clerk, Daniella Thomas made a correction on the record for the fine amounts for each case.

Motion:

Deputy City Manager Sheila Rose, after hearing the cases C14090258 and C15040479 on the subject property, made a motion to reduce the aggregated fines to a total of \$12,000.00 inclusive of the administrative fee. This would be paid over 12 months, \$1,000.00 each month. The agreed upon amount would be paid by the 10th of every month and if the payment lapses over 5 days the fines will revert back to the lien amount filed with Broward County. The motion was seconded by Director of Finance and Administrative Services Peta-Gay Lake.

Mr. Cotton agreed to the proposed motion and asked for the payment date to be changed to the 15th of every month.

Motion:

Deputy City Manager Sheila Rose, amended her motion to include that the agreed upon amount would be paid by the 15th of every month and if the payment lapses over 5 days the fines will revert back to the lien amount filed with Broward County. The motion was seconded by Director of Finance and Administrative Services Peta-Gay Lake.

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Upon roll call, the motion passed by a 3-0 vote.

Senior Code Compliance Officer Briana Capone stated that the Settlement Agreement would need to be signed by The City of Coconut Creek and Mr. Thomas Cotton and then presented before the Commission.

City Attorney Terrill Pyburn explained that the Settlement Agreement for both cases will go before the Commission on September 8, 2022.
