RESOLUTION NO. 2020-004

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK PROVIDING FOR THE DELIVERY OF 911 DISPATCH COMMUNICATION SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek entered into an agreement with Broward County on August 29, 2013, to provide 911 Dispatch Communication Services to Coconut Creek as part of the Consolidated Regional E-911 Communications System; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek requested funding for alternative 911 Dispatch Communication Services in Fiscal Year 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, finds and determines it to be in the best interest of the residents, businesses, and visitors of the City to authorize said participation in the Dispatch Communication Services InterLocal Agreement, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Attachment "1."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the Dispatch Communication Services InterLocal Agreement, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Attachment "1," by and between the City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek, which authorizes the City's participation in the 911 Dispatch Communications System agreement through December 31, 2029, renewable on the agreement of the parties for two (2) additional five (5) year terms.

<u>Section 3:</u> That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the attached agreement between the City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek providing for delivery of 911 Dispatch Communication Services.

<u>Section 4:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
