## **1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER / WELCOME**

Mayor Sandra Welch called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m. She advised that there would not be a roundtable at the end of this meeting, as participants were instead invited to experience the Hate Ends Now Holocaust exhibit.

## **2. AGENDA ITEMS**

### **a. Police Department Update**

Deputy Police Chief Henry Cabrera shared a brief update. He stated Broward County Public Schools Superintendent Dr. Howard Hepburn had recently taken part in the Do the Right Thing program, and reminded principals and administrators to encourage their teachers to continue nominating students for Do the Right Thing so Coconut Creek could recognize more students.

Sergeant Dan Eberly advised that K9 Taylor would not be in the schools for the next few weeks due to training and preparation for certification. He reminded educators to not hesitate in calling him at any time.

### **b. Fire Rescue Update**

Fire Chief Brian Blizzard introduced himself and provided a brief Fire Rescue Department update. He shared that the Cadet Program was doing well, explaining the program was for students 14-20 years old to learn the ins and outs of the Fire Rescue Department. Fire Chief Blizzard responded to a question regarding the C.E.R.T program, advising that interested high school students should complete the Cadet Program as a first step.

### **c. Student Awards**

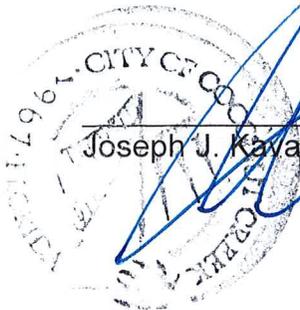
Government Affairs Manager Bernadette Hughes stated information would soon be going out to the schools on the City's Annual Student Awards Ceremony. She advised that the City would be separating the awards ceremony into two ceremonies, one for elementary and middle school students and one for high school students. She reminded the principals that elementary and middle schools could nominate up to 10 students each and high schools could nominate up to five (5) students each. She encouraged principals to be actively engaged in the awards ceremony, and to share any suggestions for improvements with her.

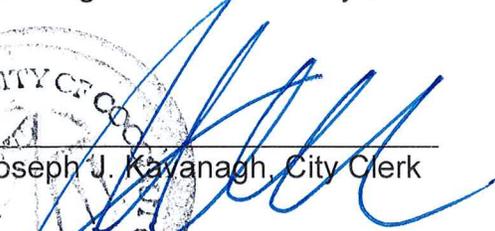
**3. HATE ENDS NOW HOLOCAUST EXHIBIT**
