

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-057

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE SOLE SOURCE INTERNET-BASED SOFTWARE RENEWAL AGREEMENT AND MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK AND LEADSONLINE, LLC, PROVIDING FOR A REAL-TIME CRIME INVESTIGATIVE SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, LeadsOnline Real Time Crime System is an investigative platform that allows investigators instant alert notifications on crime-related pawn transactions, trends, and associated suspects from within and outside the City’s jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City previously entered into an agreement with LeadsOnline, LLC, which expires this year; and

WHEREAS, there is no other online investigative research tool that provides the combination of data features and capabilities as found in LeadsOnline; and

WHEREAS, the agreement provides for an annual subscription for three (3) years in the amount of Fifty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars (\$55,288) with the option to renew for a fourth year at a future rate, yet to be determined.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the renewal agreement and MOU between the City of Coconut Creek and LeadsOnline, LLC for the purpose of accessing additional information exchanges to help solve crimes.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said renewal agreement and MOU between the City of Coconut Creek and LeadsOnline, LLC, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
