At approximately 12:49 p.m., you and Officer Cummings responded to Nail Spa in the Coconut Creek Plaza in reference to an 88-year-old female victim who was unconscious and not breathing. After removing her from her wheelchair and placing her on the ground, there was no pulse detected and AED pads were applied to her body.

The following day, Officer Cummings made contact with the female's son who advised, unfortunately, his mom passed away just after midnight. He was very grateful for your efforts to save his mother.
