

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-048

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-004 AND THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK DATED JANUARY 23, 2020; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT IN ITS PLACE PROVIDING FOR THE DELIVERY OF 911 DISPATCH COMMUNICATION SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2020, the City of Coconut Creek approved and executed an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek providing for 911 dispatch services for four cities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Springs updated the ILA and Exhibits "A" and "B" of the ILA for delivery of 911 dispatch services to provide for three cities instead of the originally proposed four; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek is desirous of rescinding the ILA dated January 23, 2020, and replacing it with the updated ILA, attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby rescinds Resolution No. 2020-004 and the Interlocal Agreement dated January 23, 2020.

Section 3: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached updated Interlocal Agreement between the City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek providing for delivery of 911 dispatch services.

Section 4: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the attached updated Interlocal Agreement between the City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek providing for the delivery of 911 dispatch services.

Section 5: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
