

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-064

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED BROWARD COUNTY MULTI-AGENCY GANG TASK FORCE AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23 of the Florida Statutes, the “Florida Mutual Aid Act,” the Coconut Creek Police Department and other Broward County agencies have the authority to enter into the attached Multi-Agency Gang Task Force Agreement (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, by entering into the Agreement, the participating agencies will be able to join together to create a multi-jurisdictional unit known as the Broward County Multi-Agency Gang Task Force to provide for operational assistance with street gangs and criminal activity across jurisdictional lines in Broward County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is to the advantage of the Coconut Creek Police Department to receive and extend mutual aid in the form of law enforcement services with other Broward County Law Enforcement Agencies in order to respond to continuing multi-jurisdictional criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement shall remain effective until April 30, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby approves the Broward County Multi-Agency Gang Task Force Agreement among the City of Coconut Creek and Broward County Law Enforcement Agencies.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said Broward County Multi-Agency Gang Task Force Agreement among the City of Coconut Creek and Broward County Law Enforcement Agencies.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part, or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
