

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-035

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED SOLE SOURCE END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK AND SCHOOL SAFETY GRANT, LLC FOR USE OF THE ACTIVE LAW ENFORCEMENT RESPONSE TECHNOLOGY (ALERT) SYSTEM SOFTWARE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City was previously awarded the School Safety Grant in February 2020, which was used to purchase the Active Law Enforcement Response Technology (ALERT) system software and hardware; and

WHEREAS, ALERT provides law enforcement with E-mapping, remote door access, real time videos, and PA system announcements during an in-progress incident; and

WHEREAS, the ALERT system software and hardware was installed in the City's Real Time Crime Center (RTCC), which provides the RTCC with a floor plan map of cameras in City buildings and instant notification in case of an active shooter or other life-threatening incident; and

WHEREAS, using the cameras and floor plan maps, the RTCC can guide officers directly to the problem; and

WHEREAS, this agreement provides a license to use the software, maintenance, as well as initial onboarding and training for the ALERT System; and

WHEREAS, the term of this agreement is five (5) years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Sole Source End User License Agreement for use of the ALERT system.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the sole source agreement, attached hereto and made a part hereof, between the City of Coconut Creek and School Safety Grant, LLC.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
