

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK AND RONALD R. SCHULTZ FOR DEMOGRAPHIC SERVICES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND PREPARATION OF GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES OF CITY COMMISSION DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF CITY COMMISSION MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 908 of the City Charter, the Commission shall establish and appoint a Re-Districting Board by July 15, 2026, said Board last having been convened in 2018; and

WHEREAS, Ronald R. Schultz possesses the knowledge, ability, professional skills and qualifications to perform services and covenants necessary for the City's Re-Districting Board; and

WHEREAS, the City has retained the services of Ronald R. Schultz in previous years in order to satisfy the Charter-driven re-districting requirements; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to contract for such services with Ronald R. Schultz due to his technical expertise and historical knowledge of the City's demographic data.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and Ronald R. Schultz for demographic services for the development and preparation of City Commission Districts for the election of City Commission members.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and Ronald R. Schultz.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
