ANNUAL PERFORMANCE REVIEW OF CITY ATTORNEY

City Attorney Pyburn noted that she provided the City Commission with an annual report of services provided by the City Attorney's Office and thanked the Commission for a great year.

Commissioner Tooley commented that she gave City Attorney Pyburn all excellent ratings and was in favor of a five percent pay increase.

Commissioner Belvedere agreed with Commissioner Tooley's comments.

Vice Mayor Welch commented on City Attorney Pyburn's accomplishments during the past year and her integrity. She spoke about her local, state, and national recognition as an exemplary municipal attorney and commented that she looked forward to her hiring an additional assistant city attorney.

City Attorney Pyburn noted that she had individual meetings with each Commissioner to discuss the annual review.

Mayor Rydell spoke about City Attorney Pyburn's work on the Telecommunications Ordinance and her excellent reputation.
