RESOLUTION NO. 2021-200

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) TOWARD THE SALARIES FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY-SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$37,500) FOR APPARMOR SOFTWARE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has established a Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the receipt and disbursement of forfeiture monies, pursuant to the Federal Department of Justice and State Forfeiture Fund Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested that the City Commission make an appropriation from said funds; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the above request will be utilized to help fund salaries of the School Resource Officers for Fiscal Year 2022 and AppArmor software; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation of funds complies with the requirements of the Department of Justice and State Forfeiture Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission hereby approves the appropriation of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) from the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund Department of Justice Account to help fund salaries for School Resource Officers for Fiscal Year 2022; and Thirty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$37,500) from State Law Enforcement Trust Funds for AppArmor Software.

<u>Section 3:</u> That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to proceed with the above expenditures from forfeiture funds.

<u>Section 4:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
