

Section 907. - Charter Review; Charter Review Board.

In January, 1980, and every five (5) years thereafter, the Commission shall in January appoint a Charter Review Board consisting of five (5) electors of the City, one (1) from each district, holding no other office, appointment or employment in the government of the City of Coconut Creek except on advisory bodies of the City. In addition, the Commission may appoint a Charter Review Board at any other time as it may deem necessary or desirable. Such Board shall review the Municipal Charter, and within one hundred twenty (120) days after such appointment, submit to the Commission such alteration, revisions, and amendments, if any, to this Charter, as in its judgment are desirable. The Commission shall submit to the electors not later than the next succeeding general election or municipal election any such proposed alterations, revisions, or amendments. The members appointed to said Board shall serve without compensation and their terms shall expire one hundred twenty (120) days after their appointment.
