Attend in-person at the Fort Lauderdale Marriott Coral Springs Hotel located at 11775 Heron Bay Boulevard, Coral Springs, FL 33076. The doors will open at 5:30 p.m. The hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. with introductions and a formal presentation, followed by a formal comment period. If you desire to make a verbal statement during the formal comment period, you will be asked to complete a Speaker Request Card. Verbal comments can also be made directly to a Court Reporter.

Project exhibits will be on display, and members of the study team will be available to answer questions. The same informational project video played at the virtual hearing will be shown at the inperson hearing. People wishing to submit written comments/questions may do so at the hearing venue or by contacting the project manager.

### PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The proposed improvements include widening of the Sawgrass Expressway and Florida's Turnpike, and improvements to the US 441, Lyons Road, and Florida's Turnpike interchanges with the Sawgrass Expressway. The improvements include direct connections between Florida's Turnpike and the planned SW 10th Street Connector project.
