RESOLUTION NO. 2016-296

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE MUTUAL AID ATTACHED AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION VOLUNTARY BETWEEN MEMBER AGENCIES OF THE CHILD ABDUCTION RESPONSE TEAM (CART) AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Part I, Florida State Statute, "Florida Mutual Aid Act", the Coconut Creek Police Department and other agencies have the authority to enter into a voluntary agreement for cooperation and assistance of a routine law enforcement nature that crosses jurisdictional lines; and

WHEREAS, the Coconut Creek Police Department and other member agencies are participants in a multi-agency effort known collectively as the Child Abduction Response Team (CART); and

WHEREAS, the Coconut Creek Police Department and other member agencies are so located in relation to each other that it is to the advantage of each to receive and extend mutual aid in the form of law enforcement services and resources to adequately respond to continuing, multi-jurisdictional criminal activity, so as to protect the public peace and safety and preserve the lives and property of the citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All Exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Agreement by and between the City of Coconut Creek and the Florida

Department of Law Enforcement.

<u>Section 3</u>: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement by and between the City of Coconut Creek and the Florida Department of Law Enforcement.

<u>Section 4</u>: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
