RESOLUTION NO. 2017-155

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE **USE OF FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS** IN THE AMOUNT OF \$331,070 FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE OFFICER UNIFORMS, BODY ARMOR VEST COVERS, AN AGGRESSIVE DRIVING VEHICLE, RADARS, LASERS. DRIVER'S SPEED FEEDBACK DISPLAY, NASAL SPRAY. MEDIA CAMERA. GUN NARCAN VAULTS, HONOR GUARD UNIFORMS, SALARIES FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS, AND SCANNERS; **AUTHORIZING** THE USE OF LOCAL ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,000 TO PROVIDE A DONATION TO THE POLICE EXPLORER POST; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has established a Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund for receipt and disbursement of forfeiture monies, pursuant to the Federal Department of Justice Agreement, and a Local Law Enforcement Trust Fund for receipt and disbursement of forfeiture monies, pursuant to Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested that the City Commission make an appropriation from said funds; and

WHEREAS, the funds for the above request will be utilized for law enforcement purposes, including the purchase of police officer uniforms, body armor vest covers, aggressive driving vehicle, radars, lasers, driver's speed feedback display, Narcan nasal spray, media camera, gun vaults, honor guard uniforms, salaries for school resource officers, and scanners, and said request complies with the requirements of the State of Florida Forfeiture Guidelines and/or the Department of Justice/Treasury Forfeiture Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission hereby approves the appropriation of Three Hundred Thirty-One Thousand and Seventy Dollars (\$331,070) from the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund for police officer uniforms, body armor vest covers, aggressive driving vehicle, radars, lasers, driver's speed feedback display, Narcan nasal spray, media camera, gun vaults, honor guard uniforms, salaries for school resource officers, and scanners, and Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) from the Local Law Enforcement Trust Fund as a donation to the Police Explorer Post.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to proceed with the above expenditures from forfeiture funds.

<u>Section 4:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court or competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
