RESOLUTION NO. 2017-315

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A WORK AUTHORIZATION WITH ABACO ENGINEERING INC. FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO DESIGN THE LAKESIDE PARK EXPANSION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department has determined there is a high demand for additional athletic fields within the City; and

WHEREAS, in 2016, the City of Coconut Creek purchased a five (5) acre parcel located adjacent to Lakeside Park from the School Board of Broward County; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department desires to utilize the aforementioned parcel for constructing additional athletic field(s) and associated park amenities; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department will be responsible for managing the design and construction of the project; and

WHEREAS, Abaco Engineering, Inc. is an experienced and qualified firm that is on the City's General Professional Engineering Services List, which was established in accordance with the Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) through RFQ No. 11-19-14-10; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends approval of a work authorization with Abaco Engineering Inc. for the purpose of designing the Lakeside Park expansion at a cost of \$170,810.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All Exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of the Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the Work Authorization with Abaco Engineering for professional design services related to the expansion of Lakeside Park in the amount of \$170,810.00.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the Work Authorization with Abaco Engineering, Inc.

<u>Section 4</u>: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
