WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and Sexton Engineering Associates, Inc. for Professional Consulting Services for Florida Turnpike PD&E Study Review dated October 5, 2017 ("Agreement") to provide for additional services as provided in a new EXHIBIT "B" - EXPANDED SCOPE OF SERVICES.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the promises and covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The recitations referred to above are hereby incorporated herein.
- 2. The parties desire to amend Sections 1.4, 3.1, 3.2, 4.1, 5.1 and 6.2 of the Agreement as follows:
 - **1.4 PROJECT.** The nature of the **PROJECT** is to provide professional consulting services for the Florida Turnpike PD&E Study Review as defined in **EXHIBITS** "A" SCOPE OF WORK and "B" EXPANDED SCOPE OF SERVICES.
 - **3.1 CONSULTANT'S** services shall consist of tasks set forth in **EXHIBITS** "A" and "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof, and shall include professional

consulting services, as applicable for the **PROJECT**. **CONSULTANT** shall provide all services as set forth in **EXHIBITS** "A" and "B" including all necessary, incidental and related activities and services required by the Scope of Work and Expanded Scope of Services and contemplated in **CONSULTANT'S** level of effort.

- **3.2** The **CITY** reserves the right to add or delete tasks shown in **EXHIBITS** "A" and "B" as deemed necessary and based on fund availability.
- **4.1 CONSULTANT** shall perform the services described in **EXHIBITS** "A" and "B" within the time periods in the **PROJECT SCHEDULE** included in **EXHIBITS** "A" and "B".
- 5.1 CITY agrees to pay CONSULTANT as compensation for performance of all approved PROFESSIONAL SERVICES required under the terms of this Agreement and as described in EXHIBITS "A" and "B" up to a total amount of TWENTY FOUR THOUSAND SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS and ZERO CENTER (\$24,000.00) (\$60,000.00). In the event the City exercises the terms and conditions of 3.2 of Article 3, the contracted fees shall be reduced accordingly.
- **6.2 CITY** shall review the itemized deliverable/documents identified in **EXHIBITS**"A" and "B" of **CONSULTANT** Agreement and respond to **CONSULTANT** in writing with any comment within the time set forth on the approved Project Schedule.
- 3. The parties desire to add a new **EXHIBIT** "B" **EXPANDED SCOPE OF SERVICES** to the Agreement.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement not in conflict with this Amendment No. 1 shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated herein.
