WHEREAS, the Coconut City Commission is committed to the reduction and prevention of gun violence within the City of Coconut Creek and throughout Broward County; and

WHEREAS, gun violence has been increasing throughout the United States in recent years and is attested to by active shooter events at the Pulse Nightclub and in Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the firearm homicide rate in the United States is 20 times higher than the combined rates of 22 countries that are considered our peers in wealth and population; and

WHEREAS, support for the Second Amendment rights of law-abiding citizens goes hand-in-hand with keeping guns away from dangerous people; and

WHEREAS, universal background checks for gun sales and a ban on all semiautomatic assault weapons are ways that gun violence can be actively prevented; and

WHEREAS, the Florida League of Women Voters has provided significant leadership in the state of Florida and Broward County in gun violence prevention through community education and the creation of the Coalition to Prevent Gun Violence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, hereby supports the mission of the
