RE: Interlocal Agreement for Temporary Debris Management Sites

Dear Municipal Managers:

On February 27, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners approved the attached shell Interposal Agreement (ILA), which enables municipalities to utilize the County's Temporary Debris Management Site locations following disastrous events.

In order to allow for proper planning for this year's hurricane season, government entities must execute the ILA by March 31, 2018. The ILA will become effective upon execution and will terminate on November 30, 2022. Upon mutual written consent, the ILA can be extended for two additional five-year terms.
