

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-193**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER (SRO) AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK AND NORTH BROWARD PREPARATORY SCHOOL FOR A PERIOD COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2018, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coconut Creek and North Broward Preparatory School agree that the School Resource Officer (SRO) Program provides benefits to the school administration, students, and the community as a whole; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City to provide police officers to serve as SROs for the benefit of the schools located within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and North Broward Preparatory School have agreed that North Broward Preparatory School will provide \$11,416.66 to the City monthly for one (1) SRO during the twelve (12) month term of the Agreement beginning October 1, 2018, and ending September 30, 2019, for a total of \$137,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement provides for up to three (3) one-year extensions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1:** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All Exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this Resolution.

**Section 2:** That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the School Resource Officer Agreement between the City and North Broward Preparatory School.

**Section 3:** That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the School Resource Officer Agreement between the City and North Broward

Preparatory School, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

**Section 4:** That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this Resolution.

**Section 5:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
