Phase I: (Planning (Years 1-2)

- Conduct survey and baseline assessment
- Engage stakeholders/partners
- Develop 3 year action plan based on assessment finding

Phase II Implementation (Years 3-5)

- Implement the action plan
- Submit progress report after five years

Serious health risks of chronic isolation

- chronic isolation with smoking 15 cigarettes a day.
- greater health hazard than obesity
- 28% >65 live alone

Leads to

- depression
- poor nutrition
- high blood pressure
- onset of disabilities
- higher use of medications
- early entry into ALFs, nursing homes
- shorter life expectancy
