PERSONAL: I am a married father of two children, ages 19 and 16, and I have been a resident of the City of Coconut Creek since 2003. I am self-employed, owning my business, Hoods Cleaned, Inc., since 1995.

COACHING EXPERIENCE:

In 2008, I enrolled my daughter and son to play ball with Coconut Creek Little League, which at the time ran both the baseball and softball programs for the City. I coached my son in baseball, and I have been coaching girls softball ever since.

Monarch High School Coconut Creek, FL Head Softball Coach 2016 – present

I have been the head softball coach at Monarch High School since 2016. During the three years prior to becoming head softball coach, I volunteered my time with the team.

Coconut Creek Girls Softball Vice-President 2009 - 2014

In 2009, seeing a need for an independent girls softball league in Coconut Creek, I joined several fellow Creek residents and became one of the founding fathers of **Coconut Creek Girls Softball**. My role on the Board was originally as Coaches Coordinator and then Vice-President. Our inaugural season was in 2010, and that year, our program was recognized by the City as the official softball league of the City of Coconut Creek. By 2011, the program had doubled in size, and by 2012, we experienced another 40% increase in enrollment. The softball league continues to thrive in the City, something I am extremely proud of and am honored to have been involved in. In 2014, I stepped down from the Board after my daughter entered high school and was no longer playing recreational softball.

Boca Blazers Assistant Travel Coach 2009

In 2009, my daughter Emily joined her first travel softball team, the 10U Boca Blazers. At the time, Coconut Creek did not offer travel softball, and this team was part of the City of Boca Raton's softball program. There were three coaches on this team when we joined, and I was initially recruited by the head

coach to help keep the scorebook. Before long, I was asked to stay in the dugout during games, and I eventually became the assistant coach and coached third base. The other coaches appreciated my help and knowledge and endorsed the head coach's decision to place me in this position.

Coconut Creek Crush Travel Softball Vice-President 2010 - 2013

In 2010, I joined two other Coconut Creek Girls Softball Board members to form Coconut Creek Crush Travel Programs. Our goal was to start a softball travel program in the City for girls wishing to play on a higher competitive level. We started with one 12U travel team. The program continues to grow, and now has two 10U teams, a 12U team and a 14U team. During my 4 years coaching with Crush, we became a strong, competitive, successful team, winning many travel tournaments. Our program has produced some great softball players, many of whom are playing at Monarch now. In fact, during my years with Crush, I coached 8 of the players that were in the starting rotation on Monarch's softball team this past season.

The following are some highlights during my tenure as a Crush travel coach:

Crush 12U:

June 2011: First place win in Thunder In Sunrise, the first tournament Crush 12U ever played in.

March 2012: Second place finish in March Madness tournament.

May 2012: First Place win in Lake Lytal Memorial Day tournament. Crush 12U went undefeated in

six games played that weekend.

June 2012: Second place finish in Boca I Heart Father's Day Classic. Crush 12U went 5-1 that

weekend.

July 2012: USSSA World Series: Crush 12U placed 7th out of 42 teams competing from all over the

country, earning a spot in the USSSA "Elite 8".

Crush 14U:

April 2013: First place win in April Fool's Slam Jam.

April 2013: First place win in Royal Rumble. Crush went undefeated in 4 games that weekend.

May 2013: First place win in Lake Lytal Memorial Day tournament. Crush took this tournament two

years in a row, going undefeated in five games played that weekend.

May 2013: Second place finish in Briana Cox Memorial Day tournament.

June 2013: Second place finish in USSSA State Championship.

August 2013: Crush 14U was honored by the Commissioners of Coconut Creek for their outstanding

achievements.

Dec. 2013: Second place finish in Snowball Classic.
