TITLE:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR THE USE OF THEIR TEMPORARY DEBRIS MANAGEMENT SITES IN THE EVENT OF A NATURAL DISASTER.

BACKGROUND:

In the event of a natural disaster, Broward County operates Temporary Debris Management Sites (TDMS) at various locations throughout the County. The County allows its municipalities to utilize their sites should the municipality choose to do so and contingent upon execution of an Interlocal Agreement (ILA).

DISCUSSION:

Executing this ILA with Broward County will provide the City with an alternate disaster debris disposal option should the City's TDMS become unavailable and/or the quantity of disaster-generated debris exceeds their capacity. There is no cost to the City should it opt not to utilize the County's TDMS.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of this Resolution.
