## AGENDA ITEM REPORT

### **TITLE:**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) TO PROVIDE A DONATION TO THE FLORIDA POLICE CHIEFS ASSOCIATION (FPCA) EDUCATION AND RESEARCH FOUNDATION.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The FPCA Education and Research Foundation is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. This donation made by members of the Broward County Chiefs of Police Association will be used to aid in costs for the FPCA 2021 Summer Training Conference.

### **DISCUSSION:**

The City is committed to retaining a high-quality workforce and ensuring public safety. The FPCA 2021 Summer Training Conference will provide highly beneficial training to Coconut Creek Police Department staff who attend. The conference will be held in Broward County this year and training sessions covering issues facing law enforcement will be discussed.
