

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-180

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED LAW ENFORCEMENT MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR K-9 DETECTION ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES WITH PARTICIPATING BROWARD COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23.1225, Florida Statutes, known as the “Florida Mutual Aid Act,” the City of Coconut Creek (City) and other Broward County Law Enforcement agencies that sign on to this agreement (“participating agencies”), have the authority to enter into a mutual aid agreement for K-9 detection enforcement activities; and

WHEREAS, by entering into this mutual aid agreement, the participating agencies will be able to continue to provide operational assistance for K-9 detection enforcement activities across jurisdictional boundaries, critical to the effective and efficient provision of public safety; and

WHEREAS, it is to the advantage of the City to receive and extend mutual aid in the form of K-9 detection enforcement activities across jurisdictional boundaries with other Broward County Law Enforcement Agencies; and

WHEREAS, the agreement shall remain effective until July 30, 2029.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement for K-9 enforcement activities among the City of Coconut Creek and participating agencies.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement between the City of Coconut Creek and participating agencies for K-9 enforcement activities.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
