ABOUT THE PROJECT

This project consists of constructing pedestrian-scale lighting along the west side sidewalk of Lyons Road, between Atlantic Boulevard and the Sawgrass Expressway, to enhance safety and visibility for pedestrians, bicyclists, and public transportation users. The construction will take advantage of the underground lighting infrastructure, such as pull boxes and conduits, that was installed by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in 2019.




(Top) Luminaire, Pole (Right), & Pole with Luminaire (Left)
