WHEREAS, up to 35% of all food produced is wasted, even though much of it is safe and nutritious and could help feed those in need; and

WHEREAS, a family of four can save between \$1,500 and \$3,000 per year by reducing wasted food; and

WHEREAS, utilizing food resources creates stronger and more sustainable communities; and

WHEREAS, we have an opportunity to conserve shared resources—such as land, water, and energy—that are used to produce and transport food that ultimately goes uneaten; and

WHEREAS, food in landfills decomposes slowly, releasing methane gas, a potent contributor to climate change; and

WHEREAS, municipalities have a special role in educating their communities to reduce, recover, and recycle food waste; and

WHEREAS, through the City's Vision 2030 plan, sustainability and the environment continue to be highlighted as priorities in our community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has successfully implemented a food waste diversion program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, hereby recognizes April 7-13, 2025, as

"FOOD WASTE PREVENTION WEEK"

and encourages all residents to commit to taking steps to reduce food waste in their homes, workplaces, and communities.
