

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-067

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,029.00; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT (FDLE) AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR THE CITIZEN ENGAGEMENT AND FEEDBACK PROGRAM GRANT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek applied for a United States Department of Justice (DOJ) Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) through FDLE for the Citizen Engagement and Feedback Program and was one of the organizations selected by FDLE; and

WHEREAS, trust and transparency between law enforcement agencies and the citizens they serve is vital to community stability, officer safety, and effective policing; and

WHEREAS, the software platform PowerEngage will help engage the community by allowing the Coconut Creek Police Department to automate its connection to residents and measure citizens' satisfaction with automated text surveys; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides \$7,029 to assist the City with the purchase of the PowerEngage software.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby accepts the grant award from DOJ through FDLE for the Citizen Engagement and Feedback Program in the amount of \$7,029.

Section 3: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached grant award agreement between FDLE and the City for the Citizen Engagement and Feedback Program to purchase the PowerEngage software.

Section 4: That the Mayor, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said grant award agreement between FDLE and the City for the Citizen Engagement and Feedback Program, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 5: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
