

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-186

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A SINGLE SOURCE SUBSCRIPTION AND SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK AND GRANICUS, LLC, PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUED USE OF THE LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE SUITE FOR A THREE (3) YEAR TERM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has been using the Granicus Legislative Management Software Suite, which is a comprehensive automated solution that enables City staff to efficiently manage the entire legislative process from start to finish, including legislative drafting, publication, subscription tools, in-meeting management, streaming and archiving services, and closed captioning, since 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City's current agreement with Granicus, LLC is set to expire on December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, this agreement provides for the continued use of the Legislative Management Software Suite for an initial three (3) year period with the option to renew for up to two (2) one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, fees for the three (3) year agreement shall be in the amount of \$95,485.38 (1/1/26 to 12/31/26 - \$30,288.78, 1/1/27 to 12/31/27 - \$31,803.22, 1/1/28 to 12/31/28 - \$33,393.38); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines it to be in the best interest of the City to enter into said subscription and services agreement with Granicus, LLC as a single source provider for legislative management implementation services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached agreement between the City and Granicus, LLC, providing for the continued use of the Legislative Management Software Suite.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement by and between the City and Granicus, LLC for the continued use of the Legislative Management Software Suite.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
