

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-188

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FROM THE FEDERAL FORFEITURE JUSTICE FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE AXON AIR SKYDIO BASIC PATROL SOFTWARE AND SUBSCRIPTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has established Federal and State Law Enforcement Trust Funds for the receipt and disbursement of forfeiture monies, pursuant to the Federal Department of Justice Forfeiture Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded \$100,000 from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) to purchase four (4) drones; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police is requesting approval from the City Commission to use the forfeiture funds to cover the cost of software, support, and warranty services associated with the drones over a five (5) year period; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation of funds complies with the requirements of the Federal Department of Justice Forfeiture Fund Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby approves the appropriation of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) from the Federal Forfeiture Justice Fund for the purchase of the Axon Air Skydio Basic Patrol Software and Subscription.

Section 3: That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to proceed with the above expenditures from forfeiture funds.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
