This program allows the City to expedite payment to our vendors. Some of the benefits of the P-Card Program to the vendor are: payment received within 72 hours of receipt and acceptance of goods, reduced paperwork, issue receipts instead of generating invoices, resulting in fewer invoice problems, deal directly with the cardholder (in most cases). Vendors accepting payment by the P-Card may not require the City (Cardholder) to pay a separate or additional convenience fee, surcharge or any part of any contemporaneous finance charge in connection with a transaction. Such charges are allowable, however must be included in the total cost of their response. Vendors are not to add notations such as "+3% service fee" in their response. All responses shall be inclusive of any and all fees associated with the acceptance of the P-Card. Vendors agreeing to accept payment by P-Card must presently have the capability to accept Visa or take whatever steps necessary to implement the ability before the start of the agreement term.

With the Butterfly Festival being one of Coconut Creek's premier events, it's imperative that the finished product represent the community of Coconut Creek in the finest light.

With this in mind and a personal requirement of Big Fun, Inc. for all Big Fun produced events, only the finest equipment available will be delivered and operated at the event.

First impressions are everything and the management and staff at Big Fun, are firm believers you only get one first impression.

From the moment we arrive on site, our trucks and equipment arrive clean, to help make that first impression a positive one. We pride ourselves in being possibly the cleanest carnival operating in Florida, with our equipment getting a thorough wash every week after being set up.

When the gates open and the guests arrive on site, they are greeted by our uniformed staff, bright lights and sparkling rides. Exactly what a first impression should look like.

Before the equipment arrives, a strategic layout of the event is implemented.

Considering placement, and traffic flow, rides, and food concessions are located with the goal of keeping crowds orderly.

Consideration is also given to the type of rides. An equal mix of Kiddie, family and teen rides is critical to accommodate everyone. We have rides, for the smallest of riders, entire family's, and those with no fear.

Upon arrival, all rides are placed on location, then set up and given a thorough inspection by our management and maintenance staff. Prior to opening, inspections are schedule through the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, who then send a State certified inspector to perform an additional inspection on all rides.

Upon completion of the State inspections, the rides are permitted and a sticker applied showing the ride has passed its inspection.

Food and games are treated the same way. With concessions providing options ranging from Corn Dogs to Chicken Tenders for the kids in the crowd, and Sausage Sandwiches and Philly Cheesesteaks for the older crowd. Cotton Candy, Pop Corn, Funnel Cakes, and Fried Oreos are on the desert menu.

Bigger is not always better. Knowing the demographics of your crowd and catering to their wants and needs is truly what matters. At Big Fun, Inc. we know the communities of South Florida and what works. It's our home turf.





PAYMENT METHODS

VISA PURCHASING CARD (reference informational flyer on following page):

The City of Coconut Creek has implemented a Visa Procurement Card (P-Card) Program through SunTrust Bank. The City's preference is to pay for goods/services with the P-Card. This program allows the City to expedite payment to our vendors. Some of the benefits of the P-Card Program to the vendor are: payment received within 72 hours of receipt and acceptance of goods, reduced paperwork, issue receipts instead of generating invoices, resulting in fewer invoice problems, and deal directly with the cardholder (in most cases).

Vendors accepting payment by the P-Card may not require the City (Cardholder) to pay a separate or additional convenience fee, surcharge or any part of any contemporaneous finance charge in connection with a transaction. Such charges are allowable, however must be included in the total cost of the bid. Vendors are not to add notations such as "+3% service fee" in their bid response. All bid responses shall be inclusive of any and all fees associated with the acceptance of the P-Card.

Vendors agreeing to accept payment by P-Card must presently have the capability to accept Visa or take whatever steps necessary to implement the ability before the start of the agreement term.

EFT

The City of Coconut Creek's Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Program allows the City to process payments to vendors electronically, directly to their financial institution of choice. With EFT payments, funds are deposited to vendor's bank account and are available the date the bank receives them. There will be no more waiting to receive payments in the mail, and no trips to the bank to make deposits. EFT payments also reduced the risk of misrouting, theft, and forgery. Additionally, an automated e-mail of the remittance advice will be sent to the e-mail specified by the vendor.

PAPER CHECK

Paper checks can also be processed by the City for vendor payments.

INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSE

The parties agree that one percent (1%) of the total compensation paid to Contractor for the work of the contract shall constitute specific consideration to Contractor for the indemnification to be provided under the Contract. In any and all claims against the City, or any of their agents or employees by any employee of the Contractor, any subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable, the indemnification obligation under this Paragraph shall not be limited in any way by any limitation on this amount or type of damages compensation or benefits payable by or for the Contractor or any subcontractor under Workers' Compensation Acts, Disability Benefit Acts or other Employee Benefit Acts. Nothing in this section shall affect the immunities of the City pursuant to Chapter 768, Florida Statutes, as amended from time to time, nor shall it constitute an agreement by the City to indemnify Contractor, its officers, employers, subcontractors or agents against any claim or cause of action. This section shall not be construed as consent to be sued by any third parties in any matter arising out of this Agreement. The foregoing indemnification and release shall survive the termination of this Agreement.
