

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-146

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A CONSULTING SERVICES WORK AUTHORIZATION WITH WALTERS ZACKRIA ASSOCIATES, PLLC TO PROVIDE DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE RENOVATION AND REHABILITATION OF THE FLEET SERVICES BUILDING IN ACCORDANCE WITH RFQ NO. 10-06-21-11; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Building is in need of a full renovation and hardening to meet the needs of the City to continue offering the services to the various departments that rely on emergency and routine vehicle repair and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted for design and engineering services to renovate the Fleet Services Building as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Building plays an integral part in the emergency disaster preparedness by not only servicing the City's fleet vehicles, including Police, Fire, Transit, Code, Public Works, and Utilities & Engineering, it also provides repair and maintenance of various heavy duty and hand tools necessary for recovery and emergency operations; and

WHEREAS, the design for the renovation, including the installation of more efficient lighting and adding a large solar array on the roof, is consistent with the strategic initiatives and goals of the City's Vision 2030 plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has an approved Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Planning and Urban Design Services Agreement with Walters Zackria Associates procured through RFQ No. 10-06-21-11 to provide for the design of the aforementioned renovation and rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, Walters Zackria Associates has submitted a proposal to provide the

requested services in the amount of \$172,795.00; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends approval of this consulting services work authorization with Walters Zackria Associates to provide the aforementioned services; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek finds and determines it to be in the best interest of the City and its residents to approve a consulting services work authorization with Walters Zackria Associates to provide the aforementioned design services for the renovation and rehabilitation of the Fleet Services Building in the amount of \$172,795.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Consulting Services Work Authorization between the City of Coconut Creek and Walters Zackria Associates to provide the necessary design services for the renovation and rehabilitation of the Fleet Services Building in the amount of \$172,795.00.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said Consulting Services Work Authorization between the City of Coconut Creek and Walters Zackria Associates.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
