RESOLUTION NO. 2025-181

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED VOLUNTARY COOPERATION MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT RENEWAL BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PARTCIPATING AGENCIES OF THE MIAMI REGIONAL OPERATIONS CENTER CHILD ABDUCTION RESPONSE TEAM (CART); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Part I, Florida Mutual Aid Act, Florida Statutes, the Coconut Creek Police Department and other agencies have the authority to enter into a voluntary agreement for cooperation and assistance of a routine law enforcement nature that crosses jurisdictional lines; and

WHEREAS, the Coconut Creek Police Department and other member agencies have been participants in a multi-agency effort known collectively as the Child Abduction Response Team (CART); and

WHEREAS, the Coconut Creek Police Department previously renewed the mutual aid agreement in May 2023 through December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Coconut Creek Police Department and other participating agencies wish to continue receiving and extending mutual aid in the form of law enforcement services and resources to adequately respond to continuing, multi-jurisdictional criminal activity, so as to protect the public peace and safety and preserve the lives and property of the citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached mutual aid agreement by and between the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the participating agencies of CART, providing for voluntary cooperation among the parties.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said mutual aid agreement between the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the participating agencies of CART, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
