WHEREAS, the purpose of National Disability Employment Awareness Month is to educate about disability employment issues and celebrate the many and varied contributions of America's workers with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the history of National Disability Employment Awareness Month traces back to 1945 when Congress enacted a law declaring the first week in October each year "National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week;" and

WHEREAS, in 1962, the word "physically" was removed to acknowledge the employment needs and contributions of individuals with all types of disabilities; and

WHEREAS, in 1988, Congress expanded the week to a month and changed the name to National Disability Employment Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, studies have found that Americans with disabilities are especially productive and motivated workers – but they still have a harder time getting jobs, promotions, and fair pay; and

WHEREAS, persons with disabilities are valued members of the City of Coconut Creek and deserve the opportunity to live and work in our community, where they are respected and rewarded for their efforts, skills, and accomplishments; and

WHEREAS, there is a rich network of non-profit agencies, practitioners, consumer organizations, school divisions, and families committed to promoting and strengthening employment opportunities for persons with disabilities in the City of Coconut Creek; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has students with disabilities receiving post-secondary education, work training, and job coaching through different programs offered by Atlantic Technical College, Monarch High School, and Broward College; and

WHEREAS, National Disability Employment Awareness Month recognizes that individuals with disabilities are capable, contributing members of society worthy of full access and inclusion in the workforce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, does hereby proclaim the month of October 2023, as

"NATIONAL DISABILITY EMPLOYMENT AWARNESS MONTH"

in the City of Coconut Creek to celebrate the contributions of individual with disabilities to our workplaces, and to promote the employment of individuals with disabilities to create a more diverse and inclusive workforce.
