ORDINANCE NO. 2023-005

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 13, "LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE," ARTICLE III, "ZONING REGULATIONS," DIVISION 8, "MASTER BUSINESS LIST," TO CREATE SECTION 13-624, "MASTER BUSINESS LIST - PLANNED COMMERCE DISTRICT" AND ADOPT A LIST OF PERMITTED AND SPECIAL LAND USES FOR THE HALE PLANNED COMMERCE DISTRICT GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF COCONUT CREEK PARKWAY AND LYONS ROAD IN THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK: PROVIDING **FOR** CONFLICTS; **PROVIDING** SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the applicant, the City of Coconut Creek desires to amend the Land Development Code in the City's Code of Ordinances to create Section 13-624, "Master Business List – Planned Commerce District," to provide for ongoing codification of the permitted and special land uses in the City's Planned Commerce District (PCD) zoning districts, and specifically, to include the permitted and special land uses for the Hale Planned Commerce District (Hale PCD) generally located at the southwest corner of Coconut Creek Parkway and Lyons Road, legally described in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the creation of Section 13-624, "Master Business List – Planned Commerce District," of the City's Code of Ordinances with the addition of the Hale PCD permitted and special land uses, is proposed in order to include the Master Business List for the Hale PCD in the City's codified Land Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines that Section 13-624 of the City's Code of Ordinances should be created and same is in the best interest of the residents of Coconut Creek.

CODING:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1:</u> <u>Ratification.</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this ordinance.

<u>Section 2:</u> <u>Amendment.</u> That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, shall be amended by amending Chapter 13, "Land Development Code," Article III, "Zoning Regulations," Division 8, "Master Business List," to create Section 13-624, "Master Business List – Planned Commerce District," to read as follows:

- (8) Self-storage facilities may be permitted in areas designated Commercial on the City's Land Use Plan, if deemed appropriate by the City consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan, Plan Implementation Element, Section 2(a)(10), Commercial Use and Broward County Next.

<u>Section 3:</u> <u>Conflicts.</u> That all ordinances or parts of ordinances, all City Code sections or parts of City Code sections, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 4:</u> <u>Severability.</u> That should any section or provision of this ordinance or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence, clause or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof as a whole or part hereof other than the part declared invalid.

<u>Section 5: Codification</u>. That the provisions of this ordinance shall be codified within the Code of Ordinances of the city of Coconut Creek, Florida, and any paragraph or section may be renumbered to confirm with the Code of Ordinances.

<u>Section 6:</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage on second and final reading.
