RESOLUTION NO. 2023-108

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (FDEM) TO PROVIDE THE CITY WITH WEATHER MONITORING STATIONS TO ASSIST IN THE DEPLOYMENT OF RESOURCES TO IMPACTED AREAS DURING TIMES OF SEVERE WEATHER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature appropriated \$1,476,000 to the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) to fund the Florida Severe Weather Mesonet (WeatherSTEM) to provide FDEM with hyper-local, real-time weather data to provide critical information to assist in the deployment of resources to impacted areas during times of severe weather; and

WHEREAS, FDEM has contracted with WeatherSTEM for the purchase and installation of weather monitoring systems in designated locations throughout the state, including maintenance for three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with FDEM for weather monitoring equipment to be located in three (3) designated buildings within the City for the health, safety, and welfare of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the MOA, attached hereto and made a part hereof, between the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the City of Coconut Creek to provide for the installation and maintenance of WeatherSTEM stations on three (3) City buildings.

<u>Section 3:</u> That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said MOA between the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the City of Coconut Creek for the WeatherSTEM stations.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
