

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-045

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A MOBILITY PROJECT TO INCLUDE BICYCLE LANES, SIDEWALKS AND PEDESTRIAN AMENITIES ALONG THE LYONS ROAD CORRIDOR BETWEEN ATLANTIC BOULEVARD AND SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2013, the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek passed Resolution No. 2013-112, in support of Complete Streets to allow all users including people who walk, bike, use transit and drive, to safely navigate our roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization and the City of Coconut Creek City Commissioners, residents and staff conducted a walk audit on a portion of Lyons Road and identified bicycle lanes, transit amenities, sidewalks, crosswalks and signalization upgrades as needed improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Broward MPO awarded the City of Coconut Creek approximately seven million, three hundred thousand dollars (\$7,300,000) within their Transportation Improvement Program to fund a Complete Streets project on Lyons Road between Atlantic Boulevard and Sawgrass Expressway; and

WHEREAS, the Broward MPO funding is earmarked for the design and construction of all the hardscape elements to include the paving, pavement markings, sidewalks, signalization, transit amenities, drainage and signage for the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and Broward County presently maintains this section of Lyons Road and would continue to do so once the improvements are in place; and

WHEREAS, the City has funds in the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for Lyons Road; and

WHEREAS, Broward County has agreed to participate by resurfacing and restriping Lyons Road from the Sawgrass Expressway to the City limits to accommodate bike lanes; and

WHEREAS, the next step is to enter into a Joint Participation Agreement with FDOT for the design, construction and maintenance of the project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

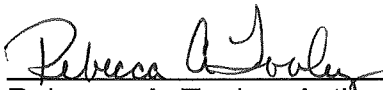
Section 1: That the City is in support of the Lyons Road Mobility Project and will continue to reach out to the residents to gather input into project design elements.

Section 2: That the City will help fund design to advance the project in the work program using a portion of the funds identified in the CIP.

Section 3: That the City will continue to maintain that portion of Lyons Road that it currently maintains, including additional improvements, after construction is completed.

Section 4: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
