

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-072

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE SURTAX FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 FORMULA-BASED FUNDING ALLOCATION ASSOCIATED WITH THE MUNICIPAL REHABILITATION AND MAINTENANCE PROJECTS (RMCOCO-002 AND RMCOCO-003); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County administers the Transportation Surtax through the Mobility Advancement Program (MAP) pursuant to the Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement (as amended, “2025 ILA”); and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek submitted applications for Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26) formula-based surtax funding for eligible municipal rehabilitation and maintenance projects; and

WHEREAS, Broward County approved funding for the following projects: NW 74th Place Roadway and Sidewalk Rehabilitation (RMCOCO-002) and Comprehensive Street Improvements Design – Phase III (RMCOCO-003); and

WHEREAS, the approved funding supports the design phase of the above-referenced projects and is subject to the terms and conditions of the Surtax Funding Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the residents of Coconut Creek to enter into the Surtax Funding Agreement with Broward County to complete the design phases of these two (2) rehabilitation and maintenance projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached Surtax Funding Agreement between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek for FY26 formula-based surtax funding for the above-referenced rehabilitation and maintenance projects.

Section 3: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said Surtax Funding Agreement between Broward County and the City of Coconut Creek for FY26 formula-based surtax funding for the above-referenced rehabilitation and maintenance projects.

Section 4: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
