

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-083

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE TEMPORARY USE AGREEMENT FOR FIRE TRUCK WITH THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS PROVIDING THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK TEMPORARY USE OF A CORAL SPRINGS-PARKLAND FIRE DEPARTMENT TRUCK, EFFECTIVE UPON APPROVAL BY BOTH PARTIES AND CONTINUING FROM APRIL 24, 2024, UNTIL APRIL 26, 2024; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, known as the "Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969," authorizes local governments to make the most efficient use of their power by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage to provide services and facilities that will harmonize geographic, economic, population, and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2024, the City Manager executed a Temporary Use Agreement with the City of Coral Springs to coordinate the temporary loan of a Coral Springs-Parkland Fire Department truck to Coconut Creek Fire Rescue to ensure continuous fire protection services while two (2) City of Coconut Creek Fire Rescue vehicles were unexpectedly out of service; and

WHEREAS, the Coconut Creek City Commission finds and determines that the City Manager's emergency execution of the Temporary Use Agreement for Fire Truck is in the best interest of the City, its residents, business owners, and visitors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. The Temporary Use Agreement for Fire Truck, attached as Exhibit "A," is incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida has reviewed and hereby ratifies the Temporary Use Agreement for Fire Truck between the City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek, providing the City of Coconut Creek temporary use of a Coral Springs-Parkland Fire Department truck.

Section 3: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 4: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
