RESOLUTION NO. 2023-175

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,080.00; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT (FDLE) AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR USE OF THE GRANT FUNDS TO PURCHASE SIMULATORTRAINING EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek applied for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant and was one of the organizations selected by FDLE to receive seven thousand eighty dollars (\$7,080) in grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the grant will allow the Coconut Creek Police Department to purchase simulator-training equipment that will assist officers in training and responding to high-liability incidents; and

WHEREAS, while utilizing the training simulator-training devices, officers can better understand how to deploy lethal and less-lethal weapons on a moving target and aim for the appropriate target zones; and

WHEREAS, having simulator-training devices is advantageous because officers can gain experience with multiple contained real-life scenarios; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City to accept the grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Commission hereby accepts the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of seven thousand eighty dollars (\$7,080).

<u>Section 3:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached agreement between the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the City of Coconut Creek for the purpose of purchasing simulator-training equipment.

<u>Section 4:</u> That the Mayor, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement, attached hereto and made a part hereof, between the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the City of Coconut Creek for the purpose of purchasing simulator-training equipment.

<u>Section 5:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
