**WHEREAS**, in recognition of Autism Awareness Month, the City of Coconut Creek continues to promote acceptance of people with autism who are our family members, friends, classmates, co-workers, and community members, as well as to celebrate the valuable contributions they make in our world; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coconut Creek strives to cultivate an inclusive environment where every member of our community feels valued and respected; and

**WHEREAS**, the Autism Society of Florida, a non-profit 501(c)(3) advocacy organization of people with autism, worked directly with the Parks and Recreation, Fire Rescue, and Police Departments to conduct in-person Autism Awareness training; and

**WHEREAS**, at least 80% of City personnel in the Parks and Recreation, Fire Rescue, and Police Departments completed the in-person Autism Awareness training; and

**WHEREAS**, the Autism Society of Florida declares that the City of Coconut Creek has met the requirements, as set forth, to be an Autism Friendly Community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, hereby proclaims the City of Coconut Creek as an
