

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-202

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FY2024 SUBGRANT FUNDING FOR THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK WORK ZONE SAFETY ENFORCEMENT PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,000.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT BETWEEN FDOT AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR WORK ZONE SAFETY ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek applied for FDOT subgrant funding for the City of Coconut Creek Work Zone Safety Enforcement Project and was one of the organizations selected by FDOT to receive forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) in funding; and

WHEREAS, the grant will allow the Coconut Creek Police Department to purchase speed measurement devices and to offset expenses for work zone safety-incurred overtime; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City to accept the grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby accepts the FDOT FY2024 subgrant funding for the City of Coconut Creek Work Zone Safety Enforcement Project in the amount of forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000).

Section 3: That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached agreement between the Florida Department of Transportation and the City of Coconut Creek for work zone safety enforcement.

Section 4: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement between the Florida Department of Transportation and the City of Coconut Creek for work zone safety enforcement.

Section 5: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
