WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the parties entered into the Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement dated, May 27, 2009 for the purpose of maintaining the landscape improvements by the AGENCY on various roads including State Road 810 (Hillsboro Boulevard); and,

WHEREAS, the DEPARTMENT and the AGENCY have agreed to add additional landscape to be installed on State Road 810 (Hillsboro Boulevard) in accordance with the above referenced Agreement; and,

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of mutual benefits that flow each to the other, the parties covenant and agree as follows:

- Pursuant to Page 6, Paragraph 7 of the Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement for State Road 810 (Hillsboro Boulevard) dated May 27, 2009, the DEPARTMENT will allow the AGENCY to construct additional landscape improvements or to modify an improvement located as indicated in **Exhibit "A"**, State Road 810 (Hillsboro Boulevard) from M.P. 0.491 to M.P. 0.998. In accordance with the plans attached as **Exhibit "B"**.
- 2. The AGENCY shall agree to maintain the additional landscape improvements, including the meandering concrete sidewalk, in the Agreement described above in accordance with Part I of Exhibit "C", Maintenance Plan, of the original agreement and Part II as follows:

II. SPECIFIC PROJECT SITE MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- The Hillsboro Boulevard trail landscape design is an extension of the natural landscape of the adjacent preserve areas. As such, there is no irrigation proposed, and the native plantings are to be maintained in their natural form, except as need to maintain clear sight lines and encroachment over adjacent curbs and paving. No fertilizers are to be used on the north side of the trail adjacent to the preserve. These areas are outside the FDOT R.O.W.
- 2. Trees are limited to small multi-trunked trees, pines and palms and are to be maintained at mature height and spread. (Refer to Part I Pruning, for clear sight window and vertical clear zone pruning requirements.)
- 3. Remove suckering growth from base of multi-trunked trees only if suckering impacts adjacent paving or clear sight lines.
- 4. To maintain the intended appearance of all palms, apply the latest palm fertilizer recommended by the University of Florida IFAS Extension per the manufacturer's specifications. Fertilizers shall be applied only within the FDOT R.O.W.
- 5. To maintain the intended appearance of all shrubs or turf grass, apply: the latest fertilizer recommended by the University of Florida IFAS Extension per the manufacturer's specifications. Fertilizers shall be applied only within the FDOT R.O.W.
- 6. Do not remove fronds from self-cleaning palms, unless damaged. Palms with persistent fronds shall only have dead fronds removed, do not remove any green fronds. If it is deemed necessary to prune a palm's fronds, no fronds shall be trimmed above 3 o'clock and 9 o'clock on the horizontal plain.
- 7. Shrub horizontal growth shall be maintained to prevent foliage from growing beyond the limits of the planting areas shown on the plan. Maintain a 12" setback from the foliage to the edge of curb, pavement, sidewalk and/or other hardscape improvements. Groundcover horizontal growth shall be maintained are 4" from the edge of curb, pavement, sidewalk and/or other hardscape improvements
- 8. Maintain the vertical height of:
 All groundcovers within clear sight triangle at a maximum mature height of 18" or less.
 All shrubs outside clear sight triangle at natural height where possible, with maximum height of 4'-6", full to ground
 Maintain all ornamental grasses at mature height. Trim down to 12" one time per year in winter.
- 9. Inspect groundcovers and shrubs on a monthly basis for maintaining full ground coverage.
- 10. Evaluate plant material on a monthly basis for pests, diseases, drought stress or general decline. If required, follow the integrated pest management program established by the Agency to ensure healthy plants.

Except as modified by this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the original Agreement and all Amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect.
